## Proposed Amendments to bye-law 6.1.1.1: The Composition of Scrutiny Committee

## Reasons for the bye-law proposal

This is an amendment to a bye law originally passed by student Senate in a fair democratic vote, that was in the best interests of students, but rejected by the board of trustees.

It has now returned to Senate as an amended version addressing the feedback from the board of Trustees.

## Details of the bye-law proposal

Add the following to bye-law 6 under composition of Scrutiny Committee:

- 6.1.1.1. An additional consultant position shall be made available to be held by a former Sabbatical Officer.
  - 6.1.1.2. The position shall be an advisory position only and would be devoid of any voting rights.
  - 6.1.1.3. The role is to be elected via cross campus ballot at the same time as those for other committee members.
  - 6.1.1.4. To be eligible for the position any candidate must be an enrolled student at Cardiff University and a member of the Students' Union during their term of office as a Scrutiny Committee consultant.
  - 6.1.1.5. Former Sabbatical Officers who are enrolled students at Cardiff University are not restricted from running for other positions on either Scrutiny Committee or Student Senate.
